The Mathematical Institute, University of Oxford, proposes to appoint a Departmental Lecturer in Mathematical Modelling. This is a 3-year and 2-month fixed-term position funded by the Mathematical Institute as part of the support package for the EPSRC Centre for Doctoral Training (CDT) in Industrially Focused Mathematical Modelling, and is available from 1 August 2016, or as soon as possible thereafter.

The successful candidate will undertake independent research involving mathematical modelling, provide lectures and classes, and contribute to the CDT's management, all as laid out in the further particulars.

With a doctorate in mathematics or a related discipline, the successful candidate will be expected to have an excellent publication record in accordance with their career status and evidence of the ability to devise and carry out an independent programme of research. They will also demonstrate an aptitude for teaching and an ability to lecture at an appropriate level and in an engaging and stimulating manner, have sufficient specialist knowledge to carry out high-quality research and supervise research projects, and have experience of, and competence in, administration.

Applicants should read the job description document before writing their application. As part of the online application, the applicant will be required to upload a statement setting out how they meet the selection criteria, a curriculum vitae including a list of publications and details of teaching experience, a statement of research interests, and the names and contact details of two referees.
