The Department of Mathematics of the Catholic University of Chile has an opening for a tenure track position at the assistant professor level, beginning in March or August 2018. Applications are invited in all areas of mathematics. The teaching load is three courses per year, reduced to two courses during the first two years. Appointees are expected to teach in Spanish after one year. The starting annual salary is approximately 41,000 USD (current exchange rate), negotiable according to previous experience. In addition, appointees will be eligible for a starting grant of about 12,000 USD to be spent over a period of two years.

The minimum requirement for applicants is a Ph.D. or equivalent degree in mathematics or a closely related field. Applicants are expected to have an excellent research record and a strong commitment to teaching and research.

The regular review process of applications will start on November 15.

However earlier applications are encouraged since exceptional applicants will be considered for an early review.

Applications should be submitted through <https://www.mathjobs.org/> and should include a completed AMS Standard Cover Sheet, a curriculum vitae that includes a publication list, and a brief description of their research.
