## Guidelines for the Written Exam

**Exam:** The written exam will begin at 9:00 a.m. (CET) on Monday, July 8, 2024. The duration is 3 hours.

**Pre-Exam Check-In:** Candidates must connect to the Microsoft Teams platform by 8:30 a.m. (CET) on Monday, July 8, 2024.

**Identity Check:** During the 30 minutes before the exam, candidates must prove their identity showing an identity card or the passport (for non-EU citizens) upon demand.

**Hardware requirements:** Candidates must have a working camera, microphone, headphones, and a scanner or a mobile device with a scanning app.

**Software recommendation:** For a better experience, use Google Chrome or the Microsoft Teams app (optional).

**Exam Conduct:** Candidates are not allowed to refer to books or notes. Both the candidate and their desk must be visible on camera. Solutions must be written on paper. The camera must remain on throughout the whole exam.

**Solutions upload:** After the exam, candidates must scan their solutions. Solutions should be saved as PDF or PNG files and compressed into a single ZIP file.

- Submissions must be anonymous. Do not include any personal identification in the email subject, body, or file name.
- All uploading operations must be completed within 30 minutes after the exam ends. Once the email is sent, candidates can disconnect from the Microsoft Teams meeting.
