PhD students can also apply, provided they obtain their  
PhD no later than 1  
st October 2016.

\*Deadline for application is 11th January 2016.\*

The annual gross remuneration is around 32,000 Euros, corresponding to a monthly salary of approximately 2,000 Euros, plus a research allowance of 1,000 Euros that can be used for exchange visits.

Junior Visitors are expected to start their research activity at CRM-PISA no later than October 2016.
